## **AMPLIFYING MINORITY VOICES AT THE UNITED NATIONS**

Justice For All Canada spoke at the 56th session of the Human Rights Council in Geneva, addressing the rise of Islamophobia and highlighting the plight of Uyghurs, Rohingya, and Indian Muslims.

Our representatives also addressed the 16th Session of the UN forum on minority issues, highlighting discriminatory laws that directly disenfranchise Indian minorities.



## SAVE PALESTINE

With several action alerts, over 100,000 signatures, a series of strong statements and memos, together, we brought attention to the war crimes and genocide taking place against Palestinians. We mobilized and made clear our demands, urging the Canadian government hold accountability for perpetrators of Genocide.

- Justice For All published the Groundbreaking Palestine report
- An NDP Motion for Palestine passed in House of Commons
- Canada Stopped arms exports to Israel
- The UN General assembly's resolution supported Palestinian statehood
- Canada Announced Sanctions against extremist Israeli settlers
- Canada announced increased funding for Gaza aid
- The International Criminal Court issued an arrest warrant for Netanyahu and Gallant
- We hosted a press conference addressing the plight of Palestinian women and girls in Gaza and the West Bank as part of our series of 10 press conferences for Palestine.





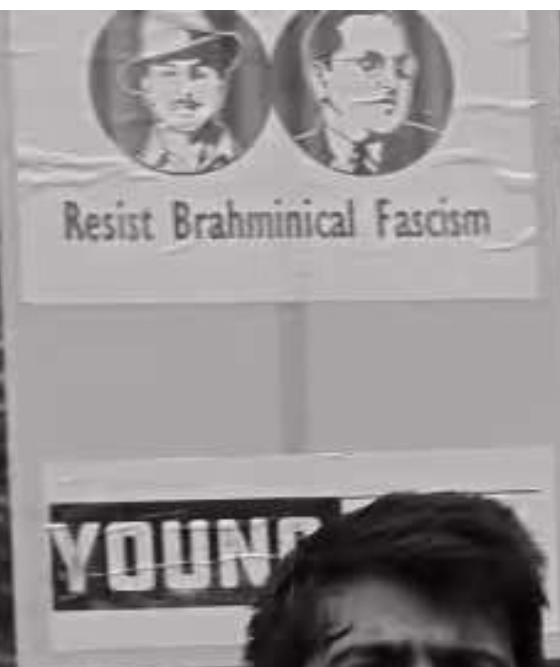
## SAVE UYGHUR

# EVENING OF GRATITUDE WITH DR.PANDOR

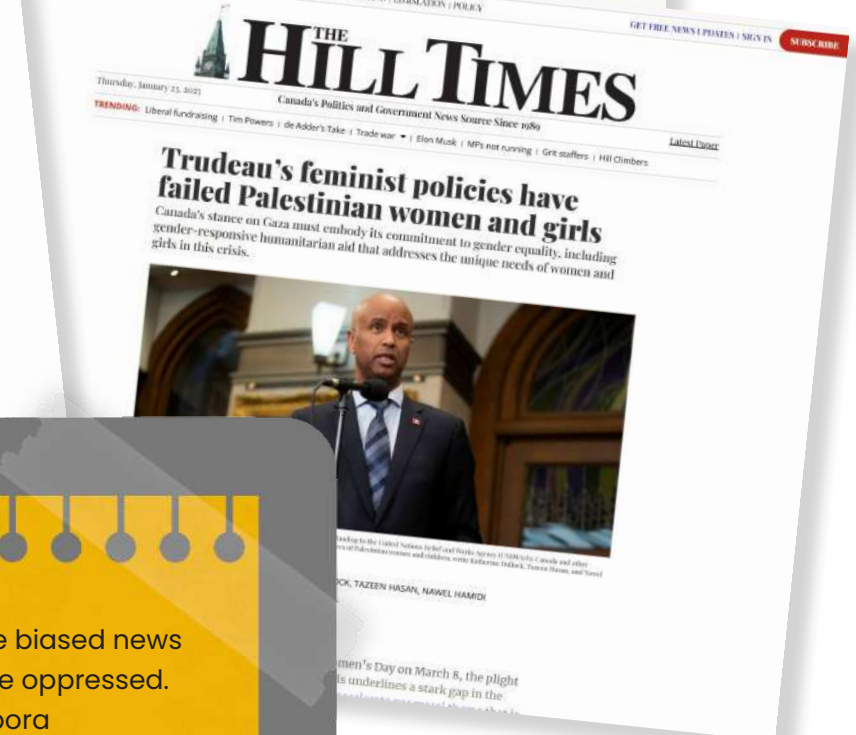
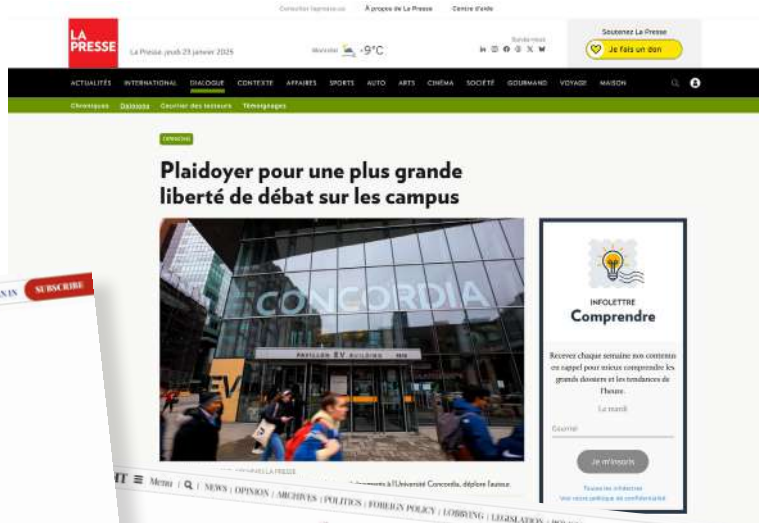

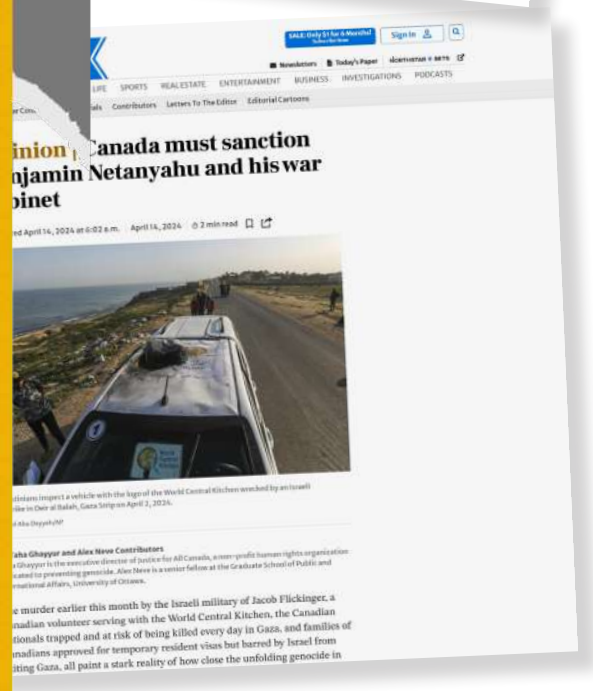
# MEDIA

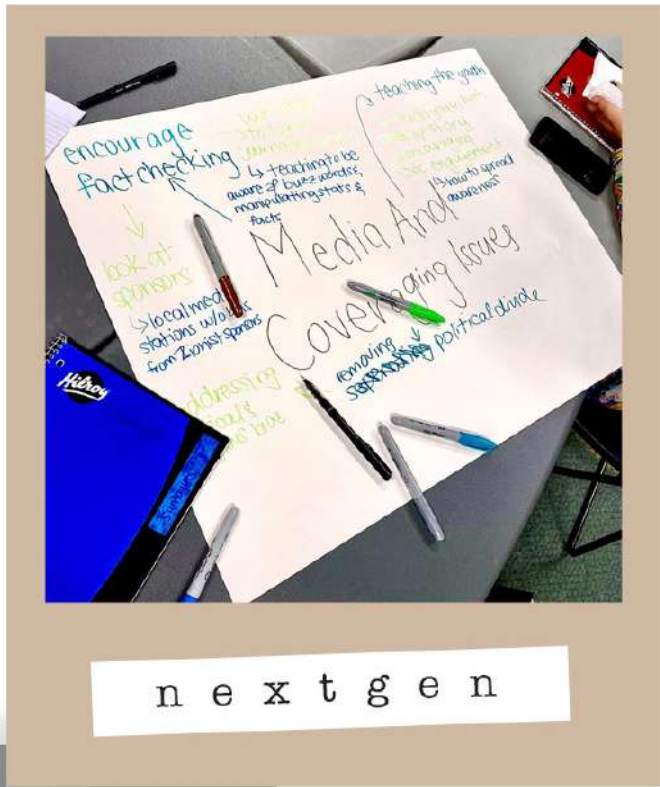
# ADVOCACY DAY AT PARLIAMENT HILL



In partnership with the National Council of Canadian Muslims (NCCM), Justice For All Canada organized an impactful Advocacy Day in Ottawa, engaging 30 Members of Parliament, Ministers, Senators, and legislative personnel. This significant event brought together over 70 delegates from across Canada, representing diverse communities, including Dalit, Adivasi, Sikh, Christian, and Muslim advocates, as well as allied voices. We engaged in candid discussions with policymakers, highlighting the pervasive reach of Islamophobia beyond borders and Canada's pivotal role in countering global policies that perpetuate hate and systemic oppression. Our delegates presented concrete policy recommendations, urging officials to implement robust measures against harmful anti-minority sentiments in Canada.

# NEXTGEN TRAINING



Learning from our partners in the US, Justice For All Canada brought the NextGen training to Toronto and, for the first time ever, to Ottawa. NextGen is a comprehensive multi-session training that covers a range of Human Rights topics that equip and empower students to be Human Rights champions in their own spaces. Over the next few years we will be bringing our transformational NextGen training to more cities across Canada.

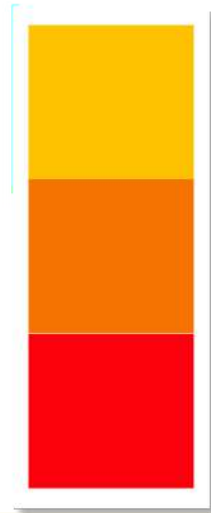

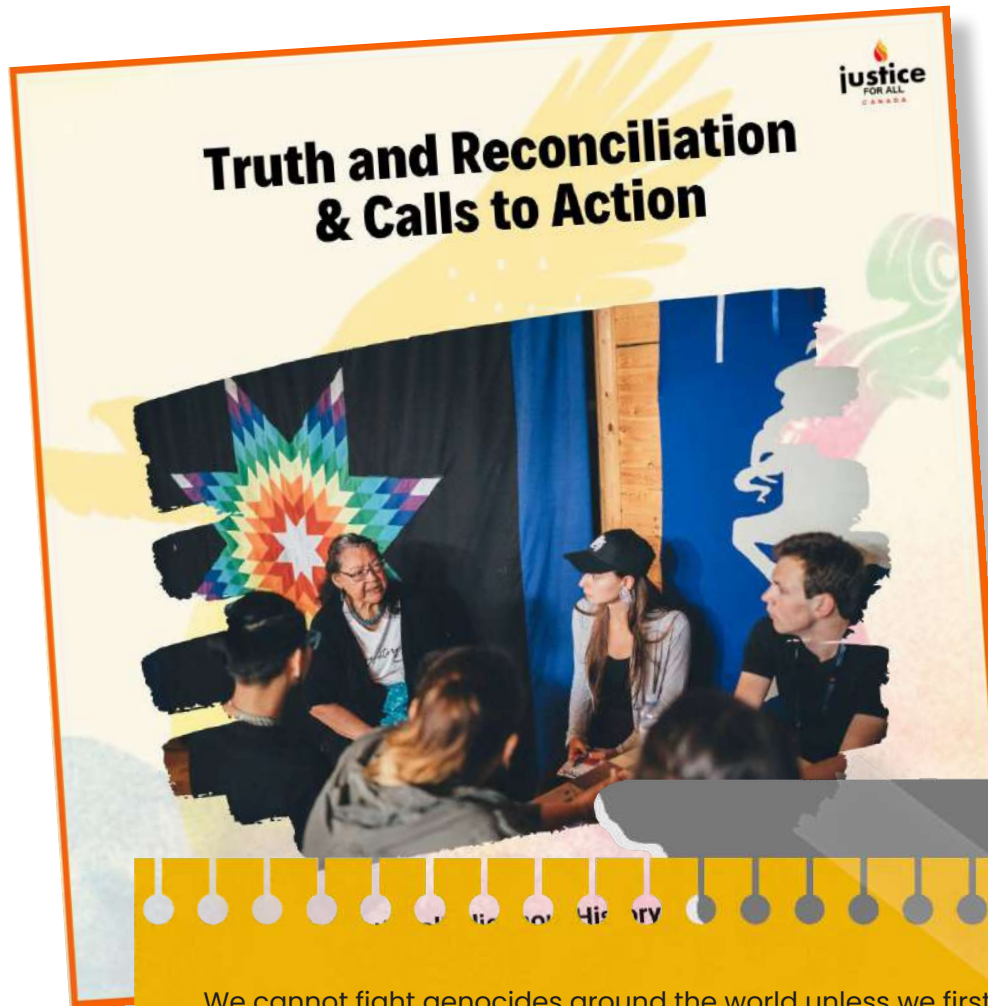
# EDUCATION

# INDIGENOUS SOLIDARITY

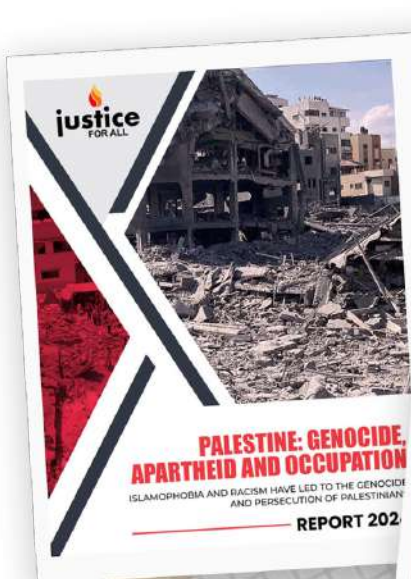


We cannot fight genocides around the world unless we first address and participate in the reconciliation of Indigenous communities of Turtle Island.

For the second year in a row, we spoke at OneLove's annual food distribution event highlighting the significance of Orange Shirt Day and our responsibility to remember and honor the more than 10,000 residential school children, as well as murdered and missing Indigenous women and children.

We also had the privilege of participating in the 12th Annual Historical Gathering and Cultural Series with the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation. As Canadian Muslims, we recognize the importance of acknowledging and addressing historical injustices and are committed to working toward a future rooted in justice and reconciliation.

# RESEARCH & REPORTS



## Palestine—Genocide, Apartheid, and Occupation

September, 2024

There is a growing consensus that Israel is committing a genocide as part of its military campaign. The persecution and discrimination faced by Palestinians arguably meets every stage of the "10 stages of genocide", a common method of categorizing genocidal situations across the globe. The critical report confirms this reality by detailing the decades of persecution and explores the impact of this genocide on Palestinian children.

It is thus critical that the international community, including the United States take action on an urgent basis to halt their complicity in the crimes committed by Israel.



## Law as an Instrument of Oppression: Unlawful Activities Prevention Act

2024

The Indian government has been using a law called the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA) to arrest individuals without trial or sufficient evidence of a crime and detain them for months. In Kashmir, nearly half of the individuals detained under the UAPA are still languishing in jail for no justifiable reason.

Using 7 case studies, this report focuses on how the UAPA is weaponized to restrain journalists and designed as a tool to suppress Kashmiri civil and Human Rights.

According to Amnesty International and the United Nations, the UAPA does not address the issue is not one of its kind.

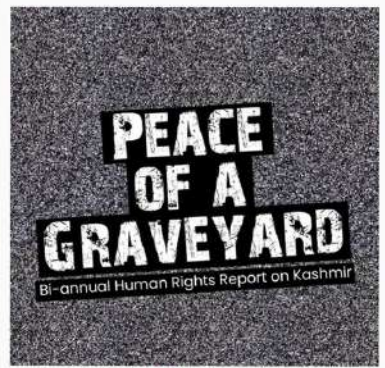

## Peace of a Graveyard: Bi-annual Human Rights Report on Kashmir

September 13th, 2024

For the past 76 years, the people of Indian-occupied Kashmir have been struggling to exercise their UN-mandated right to self-determination. The Indian state's occupation of Kashmir and its persistent repression of the political aspirations of the Kashmiri population have resulted in ongoing and egregious human rights violations. This report, prepared by Justice For All Canada, offers an overview and analysis of the multifaceted human rights violations and political developments in Indian-occupied Kashmir, covering the period from January 2024 to June 2024.
